PRESS COMMUNIQUE - 2019/2020 PRE-BUDGET CONSULTATIONS

 - (vii) addressing the impact of demographic change;
 - (viii) promoting gender equality "Think equal, build smart and innovate for change";
 - (ix) promoting a more inclusive and equitable society and further addressing the problem of poverty; and
 - (x) building greater resilience to the impact of climate change.
