The High Commission would be grateful for acknowledgement of receipt of the Instrument.

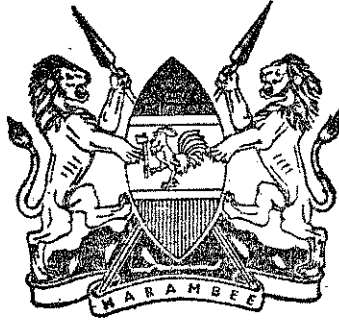

**WHEREAS** the Agreement Establishing the Collaborative Africa Budget Reform Initiative was concluded on 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2007;


**WHEREAS** the Government of the Republic of Kenya, being a signatory to the Agreement, is desirous of ratifying the same;
